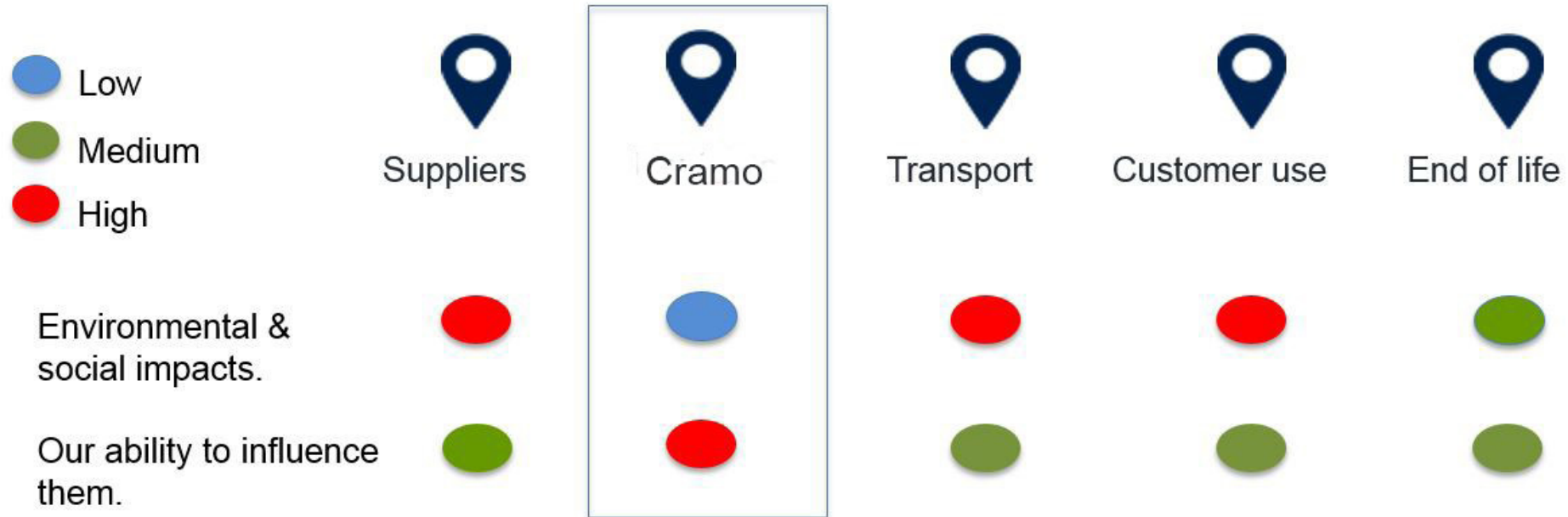


Cramo's role in the value chain
